



## Federal Fuel Charge

As of **July 1, 2023**, the Government of Canada will be implementing the Federal Fuel Charge (FFC) in several provinces, including Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, as part of the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act.

Maritime Fuels will include the Federal Fuel Charge on all applicable invoices starting July 1, 2023, as a separate line item. Some of the rates are below. A complete list of rates along with future increases can be found on the Government of Canada website.

<u>Type of Fuel</u>	<u>Federal Fuel Charge</u>
Gasoline	\$0.1431 / litre
Diesel (Clear & Dyed)	\$0.1738 / litre
Furnace Oil	\$0.1738 / litre
Stove Oil	\$0.1738 / litre
Aviation Gas	\$0.1592 / litre
Jet Fuel	\$0.1678 / litre
Marine (MGO)	\$0.1738 / litre

### **Assistance For Customers**

Assistance is available for eligible home heating fuel customers through the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). The Climate Action Incentive Program (CAIP) is a tax-free amount paid quarterly to help individuals and families offset the cost of the FFC.

You do not need to apply to receive the payment for the CAIP. The CRA will determine your eligibility when you file your income tax and benefit return and will send payment, if eligible.

Below is an outline of the current proposed payment:

<b><u>Category of Customer</u></b>	<b><u>Quarterly Payment Amount paid by the Government of Canada</u></b>
First Adult	\$124 per quarter
Second Adult	\$62 per quarter
Each Child	\$31 per quarter
Family of 4	\$248 per quarter

If you qualify for an exemption, it is your responsibility to provide a completed exemption certificate to Maritime Fuels prior to the delivery of your fuel.

**Federal rules do not allow fuel companies to issue refunds of the Federal Fuel Charge if a certificate is received AFTER delivery.**
